The Day School Program of Gateways: Access to Jewish Education, has just completed its ninth year of providing services to students and teachers in nine Boston area and suburban day schools. Our mission is to enable students with learning differences to succeed in the day school setting.

Both **speech-language therapy** and **occupational therapy** are available at Solomon Schechter Day School of Greater Boston. It has been a very successful partnership. We have services available at both the lower and upper school. Gateways services are provided for a tuition-based fee that is subsidized through fundraising and CJP support.

There are many advantages to having Gateways professionals at Schechter. The Gateways therapists work with students individually and in small groups both in and outside of the classroom. They collaborate with teachers to share ideas that benefit a wide range of students. Most importantly, they maintain a close working relationship with the child's teacher and the school's staff to help ensure the child's success.
