This position works with grade-level team leads and classroom teachers to implement and monitor the school's designated curriculum (Investigations3 for K-5) and reports to the Director of Learning and Teaching.

Job Duties:

- Collaborate with Team Leads to offer embedded professional development to teachers on the implementation of Investigations3, including instructional strategies and differentiated instruction. This support may include:
 - Side-by-side coaching with teachers and modeling of lessons in the classroom.
 - In-service professional development sessions
 - Consulting with teachers and learning specialists about students in need of specialized instruction, enrichment and support.
 - Serve as a resource for faculty on math pedagogy and content knowledge
- Manage the implementation and analysis of assessments and screeners including administering (or supporting teachers in administering) assessments and organizing data collected from such assessments.
- Order necessary supplies and materials for implementation of the curriculum.
- Attend all relevant faculty meetings.
- Additional duties and responsibilities as assigned.

Qualifications:

- Minimum of 3 years experience in a K-8 school or equivalent environment.
- Current knowledge of research and effective practices in Math pedagogy
- Experience coaching and collaborating with teachers.
- Experience planning for and facilitating professional development workshops for teachers.
- Excellent interpersonal skills and flexible, responsive work style.
